BAMBEJJA PROJECT MANAGER VISITS RUGBY

Ceri Duncan who manages the Bambejja Street Girls project in Uganda is visiting on 15th December to share more about the project with the people of Rugby. Bambejja is the focus for Rugby Christmas Cracker's fundraising campaign in 2002 and Ceri has taken time out of her short trip to the UK to come to Rugby. Anyone who wants to find out more is invited to come to Rugby Methodist Church Centre on Russelheim Way, from 3 to 5pm on Sunday 15th December. Refreshments will also be served.

Bambejja (which means "little princesses") is a unique project in Uganda, which provides care and support for the young women and girls who find themselves homeless, orphaned and living on the streets of Kampala. Ceri will show video footage of the project, and tell us more about what the project achieves with the girls in its care. Ceri will also tell us more about the half-way house that she hopes to be able to open to provide 24 hour care and shelter for the neediest girls whilst they are re-settled.

Brenda Sheil from Rugby Christmas Cracker who visited Bambejja last year comments "I'm really pleased Ceri is able to come and see us, she'll be able to tell us so much more about the project in person".
